

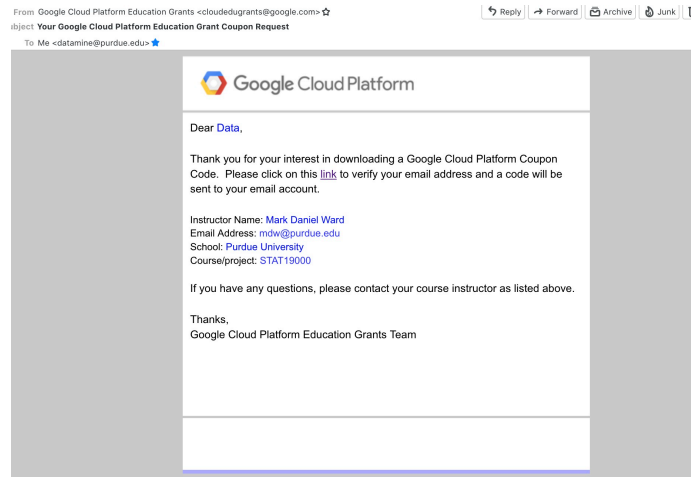

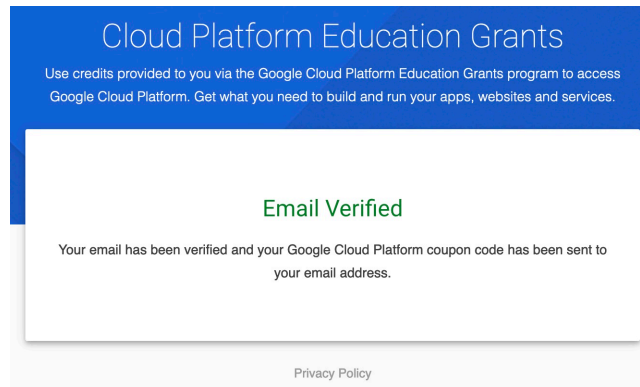

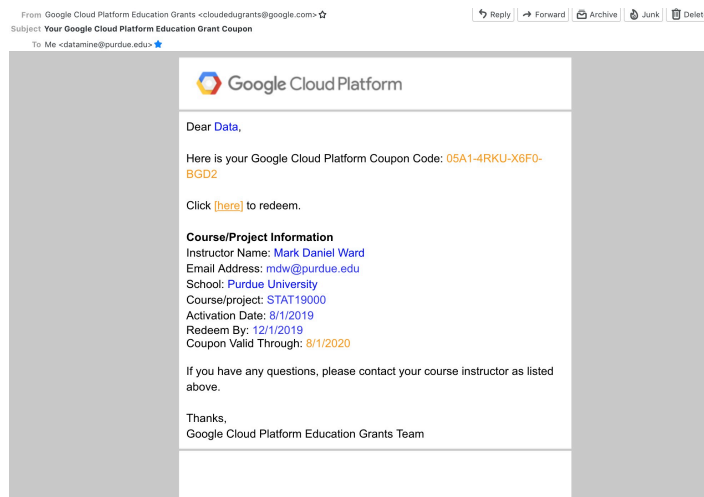
When you open your email, the email verification you will receive looks like this:




Click on the link in this email verification. This opens a webpage says that email has been verified and a Google Cloud Platform coupon code has been sent to your email address.

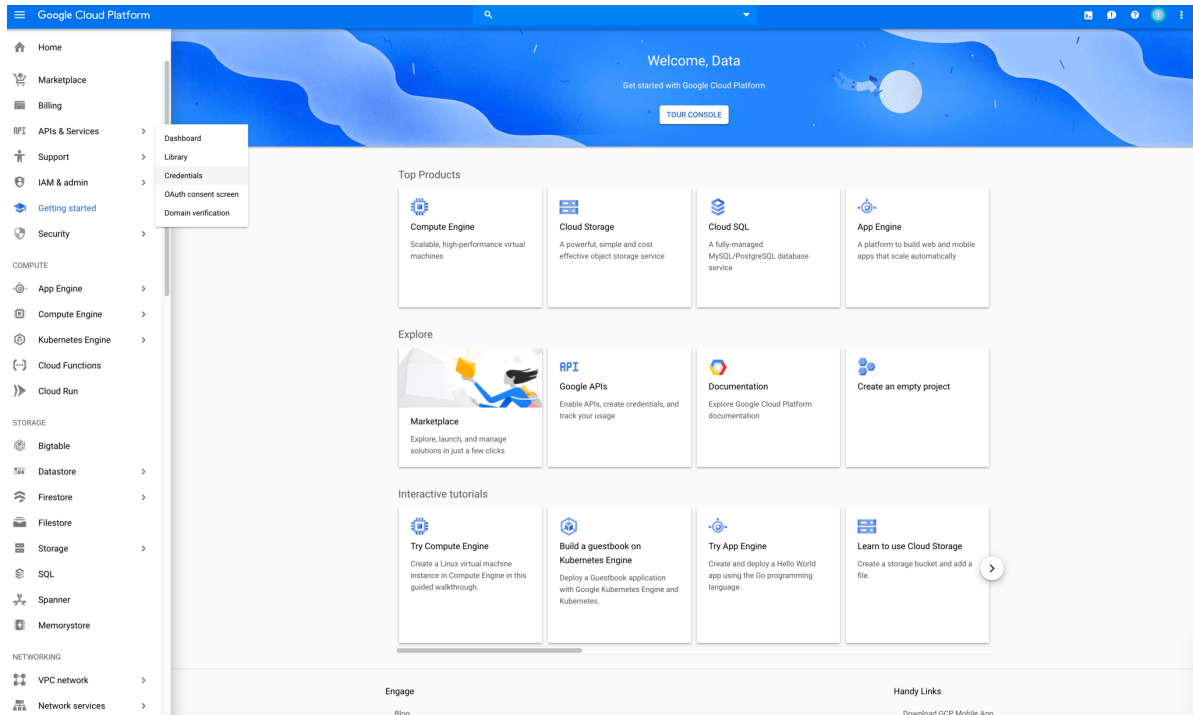

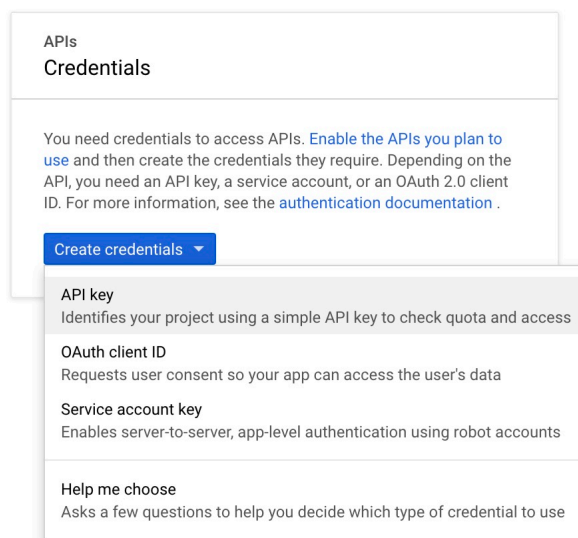

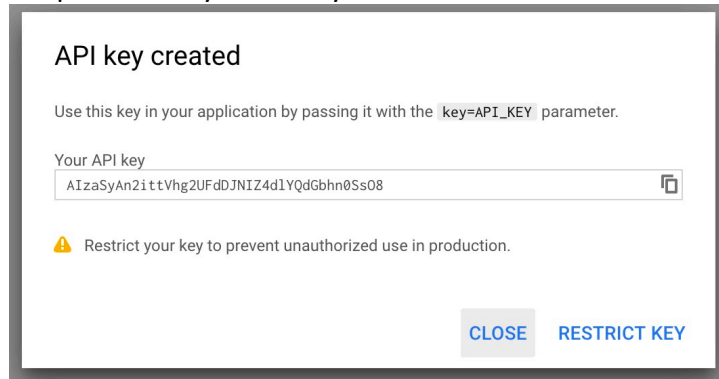
When the page is finished loading, many options for the Google Cloud Platform should open.



In the left-hand sidebar, you should choose "APIs & Services" and then "Credentials" from the small menu that opens. A new page will open, for APIs Credentials, and you press the button to "Create credentials" and then choose "API key" from the dropdown menu that appears.

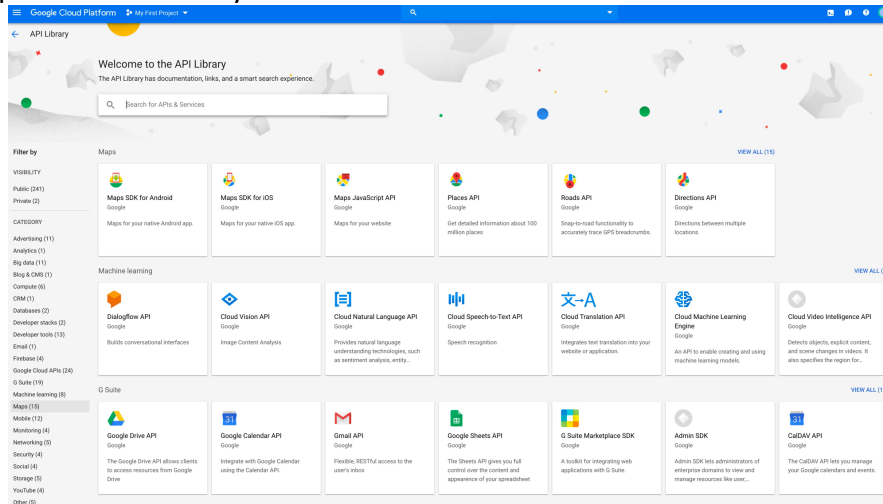


A new window should open that says "API key created".

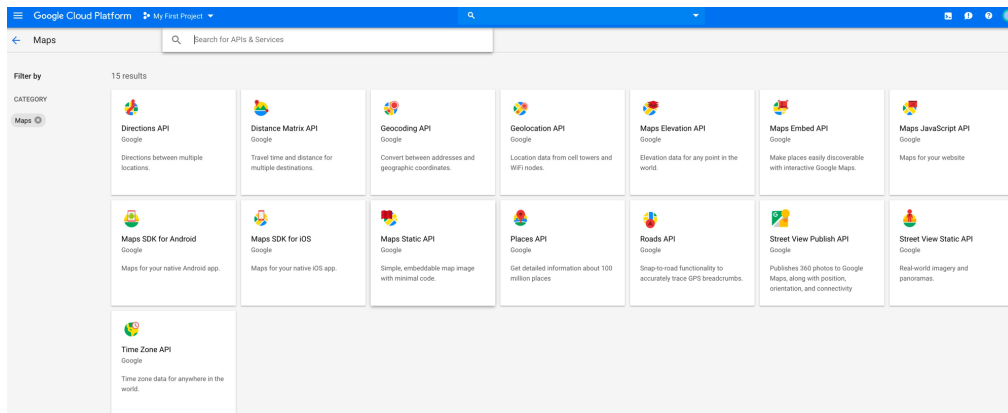


It is safe to click the "close" button. There is a little double-window picture frame shape that is immediately to the right of the long API key. This allows us to copy and paste the key somewhere that you will remember it, for later use. *(Please do not type this API key by hand. It is good to copy-and-paste, and to doing things in a reproducible, accurate way.)*

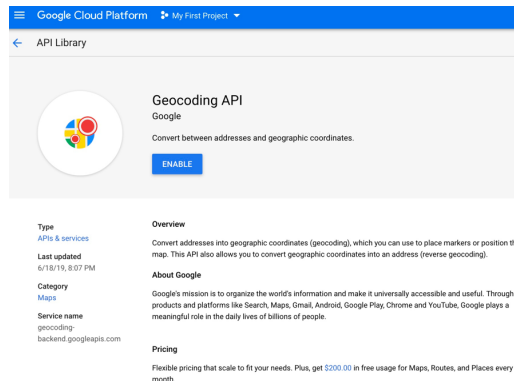
Now we want to click on the "Library" option under in the left-hand APIs & Services sidebar. This should open the API Library.



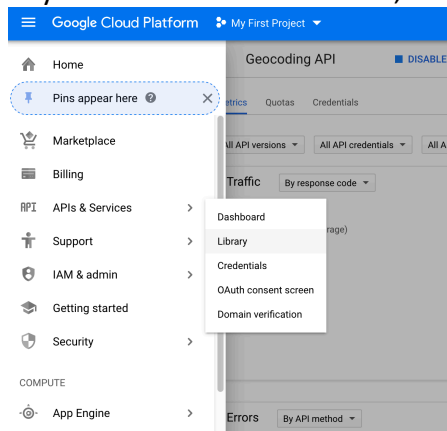
In the left-hand sidebar, choose the "Maps" option.



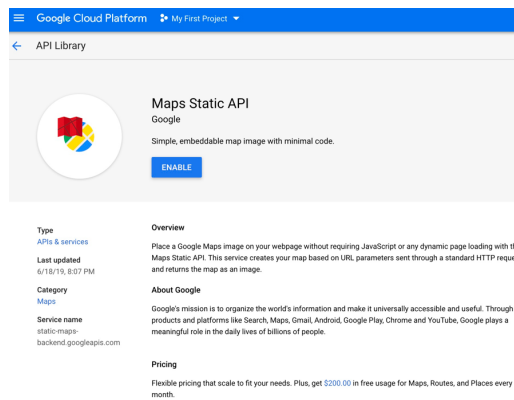
Click on the Geocoding API, and then click Enable.



After you clicked the Enable button, click the 3 lines at the upper-left corner. This causes a drop-down menu to appear, and you choose APIs & Services, and then Library.



Then click Maps in the left-hand menu, and finally choose Maps Static API, and click Enable.



Your API key should be ready to use now! Congratulations! You will use this API key for the rest of the semester, so please keep it handy! It is a useful piece of information!
